This is part of EY's executive global employee recognition program *Better begins with you*. Mark has exemplified EY's purpose of building a better working world with his exceptional achievements. In the Executive, 126 teams and individuals were nominated across the award program's four categories. Mark won the Canada award in the category "Strengthening our Communities", for his tireless volunteer work at CCS, and particularly his work with our summer camp program – a sleep away camp experience for children from low income families.
