


The Program

Children learn through arts and crafts, games, discussion and role-playing. The program promotes positive social interaction and an understanding of emotions, listening, friendships and play.



Information


The program is offered to schools and community organizations. It is 10-weeks long and held once a week during lunch hour or after school. The program is offered free of charge. It has been implemented in multiple schools across Montreal, with successful results.




The Friendship Club helps children develop essential social skills including:

This program is funded by Centraide.






